RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Date of Championship : Thursday, 19 March 2020

2. Venue : Premier Pitch @ Turf City (Indoors)

3. Commencement Time : 9.00am to 2.00pm

4 Reporting Time : All Team Captains to register latest by **9.00am**.

A draw will be conducted at the event venue on the event day itself.

5. Eligibility : Solely applicable to **ALL** employees of MOE in School only

(Important Note: All team players must come from the same school. Any player caught playing for other school team will result in the disqualification of the entire school team he or she played for.)

6. Registration : Each team shall consist of 8 players (5 players and 3 reserve) and they must

come from the same school.

Only one team entry per school is allowed.

7. Number of Teams : If there **are less than 8 teams** for the events, the event will be cancelled.

Registration is based on first-come-first-serve basis.

A maximum of 40 teams are permitted to take part in this championship.

8. Closing date for Entries : 27 February 20209. Clothing : Proper playing attire

10. Injuries : The organizer shall not held responsible for any injury sustained, during on

event, by players or officials arising from their championship's participation.

11. Prizes : Medals are awarded to the Champion, 2nd position & joint 3rd positions for all the

categories. In addition, the prize money will be awarded as follows:

12. Championship:

- a) The Tournament shall be played under the current FAS 5-A-SIDE rule except otherwise stated.
- b) There will be no offside rule. The duration of each match is 10 minutes.
- c) There is no limit to the number of substitution. However, players who are substituted cannot re-enter the court for the same game.
- d) 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 point for a loss. A team receiving a walkover will be given 3 points and 3 goals.

(Note: Teams who are present for the tournament but leave or walkover during the games will be penalized and disqualified from the championship itself.

On top of this, the entire team would be banned from future Inter-School Sports Championship Games.)

- e) The winner shall be the team with the highest number of points scored from all the matches played.
- f) In the event of two (2) or more teams having the same number of points at the end of the league, the team having the best goal difference will be placed first.
- g) If a tie persists, then the team with the greater number of goals scored FOR shall be the winner. In the event of a tie again, the team, which had won the match between the teams concerned, would be ranked higher. If everything is equal, a toss of coin shall decide the winner.
- h) 2 yellow cards 1 match suspension and 1 red card 2 matches suspension
