### Rules and Regulations

#### Rules of the Game

The Inter-School Bowling Championship 2020 will be conducted under the laws established by the Federation Internationale Des Quilleurs, the World Tenpin Bowling Association and the Singapore Tenpin Bowling Congress, as well as the competition rules and regulations laid down by the Ministry of Education Sports & Recreation Club (MESRC).

#### Registration of Teams

Each team must comprise of 4 bowlers of mixed gender who are from the same school.

**NOTE: Each school** is only allowed to send a maximum of **one (1) team**.

The respective school will have to send in their best team to compete for Inter-School Bowling Championship 2020.

#### Eligibility

Solely applicable to **ALL** employees of MOE in School only.

All current national players and ex-national players from January 2010 to 2020 and players suspended by national sports associations are not eligible to participate.

The Team Captain shall undertake the responsibility of ensuring the eligibility of their players for the tournament. Failure to do so may render the team to be defaulted or disqualified from the competition.

The Organizers reserves the right to repudiate the registration of any team or player(s) at its discretion.

#### Closing Date of Entries and Registration of Bowlers

The Closing Date of Entries is **14 August 2020**.

**Registration will be based on a first-come-first serve basis. A maximum of 34 teams are allowed for this Championship.**

#### Period of Competition

The tournament will be held on Saturday, 21 November 2020 at Orchid Country Club Bowl Centre, 1 Orchid Country Club S(769162) from 8.30am to 1.00pm. The Tournament Organizing Committee reserves the right to change the date, time and venue of the fixtures for the tournament.

#### Style of Play

Each game shall be bowled on a pair of lanes. When any question arise as to which of the 2 bowlers shall bowl first, it is incumbent upon the bowler on the right to do so. All games must be completed within 3 hours after rolled-off.

#### Order of Bowlers

The order of bowlers will be as submitted in the official entry form. Any request for change in the order must have the prior approval of the Organizers.

#### Substitution

- i) Replacement of bowler is allowed as long as the Organizers had been informed prior to the competition. Once the bowler is replaced, the bowler will not be allowed to rejoin the competition at any stage of the tournament.

#### No Slow Bowling

- i) Bowlers who are in readiness to step onto the approach shall have the following rights & obligations.
- ii) They may claim the right of way only over anyone moving to the approach or preparing to bowl on the

lane immediately to their left.

- iii) They shall give way to any bowler who is moving towards the approach or preparing to bowl on the lane immediately to their right.
- iv) Bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their turn and shall not delay by going on to the approach, if the lanes immediately adjacent to them on the left and right sides are clear.

**Dress Code (Bowlers' Attire)**

- i) **It shall be the duty of each bowler to dress properly. Only long pants (male bowlers) are allowed during the championship. Female bowlers are allowed skirts, shorts or dress shorts. Jeans material pants or slacks are allowed.**

**Ladies' Handicap**

**All people bowlers will be given a 10 Handicap points per game.**

**Grace Period**

Fifteen minutes (15 min) grace is allowed. The Organizers may at their discretion extend this grace period if they think that extension is justifiable. However, the team concerned must inform the Organizers immediately of the delay. Teams must abide by the decision of the Organizers. **The cut off time of tournament is 3 hours from the time of the tournament is being rolled-off.**

**Postponement**

No postponement shall be allowed. However, the Organizers shall, at their discretion, decide to postpone a match if they think that the venue is unfit for play, or for any other reasons for which they deem a postponement is in order.

**Protest**

Any protest during a game, on points of laws/rules, must be lodged immediately by the Team Captain to the Organizers.

All questions relating to the qualification of players or interpretation of the Rules & Regulations, or any dispute or protest, shall be referred to the Organizers, whose decision will be final.

**Other Matters**

The Organizers, shall at their discretion, decide on matters that are not provided for in the Rules & Regulations. Teams must abide by the decision of the Organizers.
